Gas leak on Hindley Street, Adelaide

Tuesday, 10 May 2011

The Metropolitan Fire Service (MFS) advises people in and around 21 Hindley Street, Adelaide that a gas leak in the building poses a threat to public safety.

Police and MFS crews have evacuated the building and neighbouring buildings. Traffic on Hindley Street is disrupted due to the street being blocked to traffic around the affected building.

MFS firefighters are responding to the gas leak, and members of the public who are in the area should follow the advice of Police and Firefighters.

MFS Commander, Paul Fletcher says members of the public should not visit the affected area.

“Those travelling in the area should exercise caution. If you don’t need to visit Hindley Street, Adelaide, please avoid the area until the gas leak is mitigated.”
