Gas leak on Hindley Street – threat reduced

Tuesday, 10 May 2011

The Metropolitan Fire Service (MFS) advises that the threat posed by a gas leak at 21 Hindley Street, Adelaide has reduced.

Gas authorities, with the assistance of MFS crews, have isolated the gas leak. Firefighters have ventilated the building and conducted tests to ensure gas levels have returned to a normal level.

The MFS advises that traffic on Hindley Street will soon be restored and workers and members of the public will regain access to the area.

MFS Commander, Paul Fletcher said firefighters would like to thank the public for its cooperation during the incident – including following evacuation procedures.

“Businesses on Hindley Street were affected by the gas leak and I’d like to thank them for their cooperation during disruption to trade,” Commander Fletcher said.
