The MFS will open the doors to the **Adelaide Fire Station** at 99 Wakefield Street, Adelaide **between 11.15 am and 3.00 pm**, providing post-pageant fun for children and families.

It will be a rare chance for the public to meet our dedicated fire fighters and staff, have a close-up look at fire appliances, view road crash rescue and Urban Search and Rescue (USAR) demonstrations and to learn a little more about how to keep you, your family and your home fire safe.

Highlights of the day include:

- An aerial rescue exercise and rope rescue from heights
- An Urban Search and Rescue (USAR) demonstration
- A close look at our fire fighting appliances and equipment
- Discovering how the cause of house and other structure fires are investigated
- Learning how your family can prevent or survive a house fire, including how to escape a fire
- Finding out what a fire fighter faces at a fire through computer simulation
- An insight into hazardous substance response
- An interactive child fire safety education display, including the 'Stop, Cover, Drop and Roll' game
- A road crash rescue demonstration.

MFS Open Day is a **free**, family friendly event involving demonstrations throughout the day, and plenty of activities to interest people of all ages.
