How we warn the community

**1** Incident starts



**2** Crews arrive



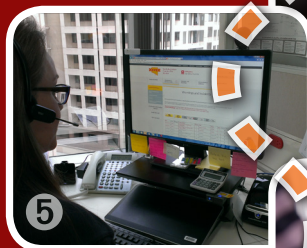
**3** Information sent to Incident Management Team



**4** Incident controller decides to issue warning



**5** CFS creates and sends warning



**6** Listen to ABC local radio, 5AA and other broadcast partners



**7** Check local TV station broadcasts



**8** Call the Bushfire Information Hotline 1800 362 361 (TTY 133 677)



**9** Follow CFS Updates on Facebook and Twitter. Sign up to receive warnings via RSS
