

FLOOD

Checklist

Use this checklist to help you prepare for a flood

Equipment connected over the nbn™ access network will not work during a power blackout.

Make sure you have a battery powered radio and your mobile phone is fully charged.

Before a flood happens

- have you checked if your area floods? Check with your local council.
- do you need sandbags? Visit ses.sa.gov.au
- do you know where to go to safety and how to get there?
- have you talked to your family and made an emergency plan? Download a template from ses.sa.gov.au
- have you put together an emergency kit? See the emergency kit checklist.
- do you have a list of emergency contact numbers you can keep on the fridge?
- have you checked your insurance policy is current and whether it covers you for flood?

If a Flood Warning is issued have you:

- activated your emergency plan?
- located your emergency kit?
- checked on your neighbours? Are they aware of the flood warning?
- checked local media for information, updates and advice?
- sandbagged your toilet, drains and around doors and vents outside?
- put household objects above the expected water level?

During a flood

- check local media for information, updates and advice
- keep in contact with your neighbours
- follow the advice of the emergency services
- do not allow children to play in or near floodwaters.

Returning home after a flood

- check local media for information, updates and advice
- turn off the electricity and gas before you go inside
- use a torch to inspect inside and outside your house and buildings
- don't use gas or electrical appliances until they have been checked for safety.

Never drive, ride or walk through floodwater
