Make sure you have a battery powered radio and your mobile phone is fully charged. Having an emergency kit ready to go can help you save precious time if you have to leave in a hurry.

### My emergency kit has

- battery powered radio with spare batteries
- torch with spare batteries
- first aid kit
- candles and waterproof matches
- important papers including emergency contact numbers
- a copy of my Home Emergency Plans. Download a template from ses.sa.gov.au
- waterproof bag for valuables.

Keep it on the fridge once completed and use it to remind yourself to check/ restock your kit.

#### We will add these items when we are ready to leave

- mobile phone and charger
- prescriptions and medications
- toiletries
- clothing and strong shoes
- non-perishable food and drinking water
- anything special you need for other family members.

If you have pets don't forget leads, food and bowls too.

## **Useful tips**

- keep your emergency kit in a waterproof storage container
- check and restock items regularly (eg. use-by dates on batteries)
- keep a list of emergency numbers near your phone or on your fridge.
