Getting storm ready

- ☐ Trim trees and branches that could fall on your home or property
- ☐ Make repairs to your roof
- ☐ Check your insurance policy is current and adequate
- ☐ Secure all the loose items around your house
- ☐ Clear your gutters, downpipes and drains
- ☐ Talk to your family and make an emergency plan
- ☐ Put together an emergency kit
- ☐ Have a battery-powered radio
- ☐ Keep a list of emergency contact numbers in or near your phone

- ☐ Activate your emergency plan
- ☐ Locate your emergency kit
- ☐ Make sure your mobile phone is fully charged
- ☐ Check on your neighbours

- ☐ Stay indoors and away from windows
- ☐ If outdoors, find safe shelter away from trees
- ☐ Ensure pets are safe
- ☐ Check local and social media for information, updates and advice

After a storm

- ☐ Check local and social media for information, updates and advice
- ☐ Check your home and property for damage
- ☐ Keep clear of damaged buildings, powerlines and trees
- ☐ Be aware of hazards such as floodwater, debris and damaged roads or bridges
- ☐ Check on your neighbours when it is safe to do so
- ☐ Do not allow children to play in or near floodwaters
