Getting storm ready

- Trim trees and branches that could fall on your home or property
- Make repairs to your roof
- Check your insurance policy is current and adequate
- Secure all the loose items around your house
- Clear your gutters, downpipes and drains
- Talk to your family and make an emergency plan
- Put together an emergency kit
- Have a battery-powered radio
- Keep a list of emergency contact numbers in or near your phone

- Do not allow children to play in or near floodwaters
